

## Fishing Dad Spinner Card

### Stamps & Dies:

ASCS-007 Fishing Dad  
Wheel Cling Set  
CCD-065 Pinking Wheel Die  
CCD-067 Spinning Wheel  
Pocket Die

### Cardstock:

White  
Bazzill 7-7125 Wildberry Pie

1. Fold 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" white cardstock in half to form card base, and layer 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" Wildberry Pie cardstock onto front.
2. Cut one 4" x 4" and one 4" x 5 1/4" panel of white cardstock.
3. Randomly spread each of the Distress Oxide inks onto the craft mat by laying the felt pad to the surface, pushing down, and swiping across. Be careful not to overlap the inks because this may muddy the colors.
4. Mist the inks with water until small beads form.
5. Gently place the first cardstock piece face down onto the water-misted inks to pick up colors. Lift up piece and use heat tool to dry (or set aside and allow to air dry). Repeat for second cardstock piece.

6. Using black ink, stamp worm/bobber image in upper right of 4" x 5 1/4" panel as shown in sample photo. Stamp worm/bobber image again onto scrap white cardstock. Color images with Copic markers.
7. Fussy cut bobber image from scrap piece, and adhere to bobber image on 4" x 5 1/4" panel. Layer panel onto card front.
8. Die cut a pinking wheel from the 4" x 4" piece. Stamp "It's your day, Dad" saying onto the wheel, making sure to line up center point. (Tip: You may find it earlier to line things up by using a stamp positioner tool for this step.)
9. Stamp fish image repeatedly onto 5" x 5" white cardstock, and color with markers. Die cut the template base from fish background piece.
10. Push a brad through the punched out hole on the front of the template base and then through the hole on the stamped spinner circle. Open the brad arms to secure the two pieces together.
11. Fold the flaps of the template base inward, and adhere corners of flaps together to form a pocket around the wheel.
12. Apply small squares of foam tape near the side opening of the wheel pocket on the reverse side, but do not peel off the tape liner yet. This will allow the spinner wheel circle to move freely inside the pocket.
13. Place Scor-Tape along edges of the pocket on the reverse side, but do not peel off the tape liner yet.
14. Wrap seam binding around lower part of the wheel pocket, tying ends into a knot.
15. Peel the tape liners and adhere the spinner wheel pocket to left part of the card front.
16. Stamp fish image onto scrap white cardstock, and color with markers. Fussy cut fish and attach to the brad.
17. Stamp tackle box image and "Happy Father's Day" saying onto 1 7/8" x 3 1/8" white cardstock, and color image with markers. Layer onto 2 1/8" x 3 3/8" Wildberry Pie cardstock, and adhere to inside of card.
